Musical creativity is woven throughout Prettygate Schools by rich and engaging music lessons. Children are encouraged to perform, listen to, review and evaluate music from a range of periods, genres, and styles. In weekly assemblies, they learn to sing and use percussion instruments, bringing together the school community to celebrate events throughout the year. Children have the opportunity to learn a variety of musical instruments during class music lessons, and from a range of outside peripatetic teachers, whereby our children learn musical notation, and explore how music is composed. The school boasts a popular after school choir club, which provides the children with the opportunity to visit the O2 in London as part of the Young Voices choir, and children in KS2 are able to join a band – 'Band-it', which further enriches the curriculum. The children's talents are showcased to our wider community by means of several performances dotted throughout the year, from Christmas nativities, to the Year 6 leavers' performance.
