Read on below to find out what your children will be learning this term.

English

We begin our English work in the summer term by looking at **Adventure at Cambury Park**. This unit focuses upon dialogue between characters. Our second narrative writing unit **The Cobbler of Krakow** develops action within narratives. Later in the term we will be exploring persuasive writing using the context of letter writing. Our whole class reading texts this term are **The Land of Roar** by Jenny McLachlan and **The Girl who Stole an Elephant** by Nizrana Farook. Our whole school focus of handwriting and spelling will continue, with specific lessons to develop children's skills.

Maths

We will be continuing our work with decimals and develop our understanding of money, time, statistics, shape and position and direction. We will continue our focus upon times-tables through additional paper practise and daily TTRS access at school, in preparation for the national Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) in June 2026.

Science

During science lessons, we begin by looking at **Food-chains**. This continues on from our work in the spring term about **Animals and their habitats**. The following topic in science is **Electricity**. We will link this to our D&T topic, creating a night light.

Other subjects

In geography, we are finding out about **Rivers** and in history, the children will be learning about the **Vikings**, focusing on struggles and conflict. French lessons will continue, with the children learning about their families and their homes. In music, the children will have whole class ukulele lessons, led by Mr Webb, our peripatetic music teacher.

Please ensure your child brings their reading book, reading diary and a named water bottle into school every day. As the term gets hotter please provide your child with a protective hat.
