Read Write Inc. Phonics and Fresh Start

- Older children who need to ‘catch up’ Year 3 and 4.
- Fresh Start – Year 5 and Year 6
- Taught in groups based on their stage of reading

Children will bring home a RWI Phonics book that expertly matches with the books they are reading in school during Phonics.

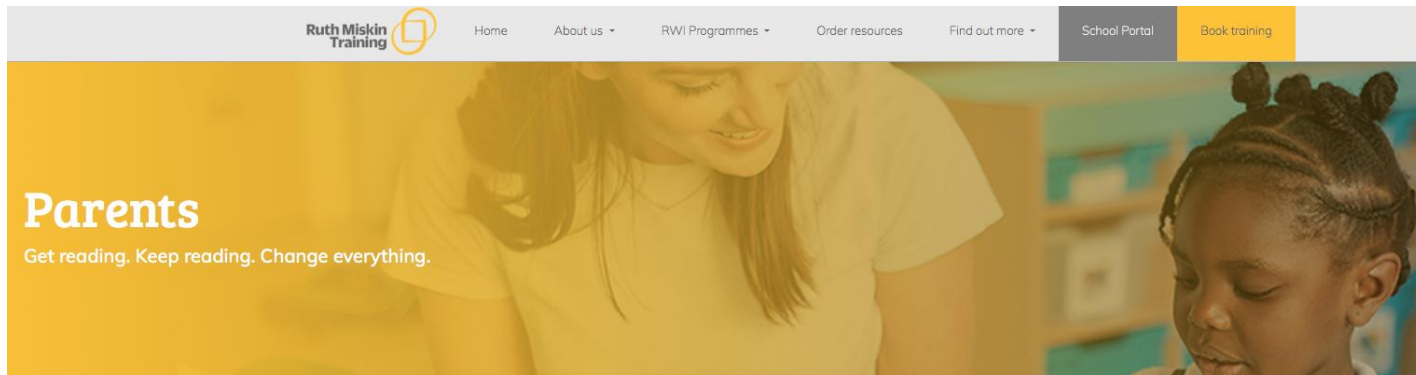
They will also have access to an Oxford Reading Tree book that correlates to where they are in RWI. The idea is that when children have finished the 10 colour RWI books they can take an ORT book home as well as their RWI book.

Your children have access to the www.oxfordowl.com home learning log in cards and they have practice reading at home. Log in's are usually kept inside their reading diaries.

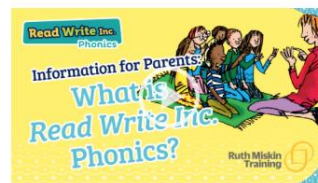


Read Write Inc. Phonics – information for parents
