PROGRESS SCORES – KS2 only

These scores show how much progress pupils at Prettygate Junior School made between the end of Key Stage 1 and the end of Key Stage 2, compared to pupils across England who achieved similar results at the end of Key Stage 1. Most schools have progress scores between -5 and +5.

Progress scores should be interpreted with caution. We know from national data that pupils at junior schools, on average, have higher attainment scores at the end of Key Stage 2 than pupils at all other primary schools. However, on average, they also have lower progress scores. This may be for a variety of reasons and should be taken into account when comparing their results to schools which start educating their pupils from the beginning of Key Stage 1.
